PCP(f)- Medical Transfer Service

Thunder Airlines is looking to hire a qualified Primary Care Paramedic (who meets Ornge requirements for flight paramedic) to join our Medical Transfer Service (MTS) in Thunder Bay. For over 25 years, Thunder Airlines has established itself as a leader in prehospital care providing Air Ambulance services on behalf of Ornge. In 2015 our Medical Transfer Service began operating in Thunder Bay to facilitate patient transfers to and from the airport and Thunder Bay Regional Health Science Centre. Staffing for our MTS includes one Ornge Base Hospital certified PCP(f) and one driver to assist with patient lifting, vehicle checks, and post-call cleaning. Our MTS Paramedics have all the same qualifications and training as our Flight Paramedics and therefore will have the opportunity to work and gain experience on flight shifts as well.

Job Description

- Provide medical care and treatment according to BLSPCS/ALSPCS and Ornge Base Hospital Medical Directives.
- Transfer patients to and from Thunder Bay Airport and Thunder Bay Regional Health Science Center or other destinations as directed by Ornge.
- Complete daily vehicle inspections, re-stock medical equipment, and ensure all routine and post-call cleaning and disinfecting is completed as required.

Qualifications

- Meet all qualifications of a Primary Care Paramedic in accordance with Ontario Reg. 257/00 under the Ambulance Act
- A-EMCA Certification
- Successful completion of an approved Aeromedical Theory Program (Ornge)
- Valid First Aid and HCP Level CPR
- Successful completion of an approved aeromedical patient care examination
- Current and up-to date immunization record and free of communicable disease as required by the Ambulance Act.
- Class F drivers licence that remains in good standing in accordance with the Ambulance Act

Additional Information

- Candidates must be willing to relocate to Thunder Bay as a condition of employment
- References will be requested from those invited to an interview
- Successful candidates will receive a conditional offer of employment pending further evaluation including Ornge Base Hospital certification
- Onboarding process will require candidate to provide a Criminal Record/Vulnerable Sector Search, Driver's Abstract and Health Status Form (signed by a physician or delegate)
- Additional certifications including Transportation of Dangerous Goods by Air and Restricted Radio Licence will be complete during onboarding if required.
